### Appendix on the application for appointment in the financing of staffing measures from tuition fees outside the Network for Quality in Studies and Teaching

It is not permissible to finance the basic programme to be provided out of the tuition fees, even to compensate for the resulting losses in the performance-based resources allocation. A comparative benchmark for improving teaching and study conditions is primary care, consisting of the compulsory events plus the minimum of elective events (one elective (compulsory) subject for each elective (compulsory) area). Teaching capacities for primary care must be financed out of budget resources. Teaching contracts and employment positions beyond the scope of primary care may then also be paid for out of tuition fees.

Taking these requirements into account, the staffing measure applied for will serve to improve teaching or study conditions, for the following reasons:

to carry out additional practical examinations, re-sits and targeted extra tuition as well as tutorials and related training.

### 2. Student assistants

- To help with concepts to improve lecture notes and practical exercise documents as well as learning and teaching materials (also creating new learning materials, free scripts, materials CDs, readers at all lectures),
  - deploying student assistants to carry out tutorials and the related training, leading small group exercises.

#### 3. Lecturers

- - To extend the teaching offer,
  - to reduce overload,
  - to improve the support ratio with smaller group sizes in lectures.
